TIES

There are two ties. The first tie is for District 1 Alternate between Michael Lawler and Michael Sandler. The winner will be the third District 1 Alternate. The second tie is between Annalisa Robles and Norfina Joves for District 3 Representative. The winner will be the third District 3 Representative and the other will be an Alternate. The GEPENC Election Procedures states that a coin flip will settle a tie. We request those four candidates involved in a tie be present at the first board meeting. As the first agenda item, a DONE representative will flip the coin to settle the ties.

FIRST MEETING

The first board meeting is on the October 24th, 7pm at the Echo Park Library (1410 Temple St.) We request all board members to be present and anyone from the community is welcomed to come. The new board will have an opportunity and plan to appoint, recruit, or elect up to nine Officers, as provided in the "GEPENC" bylaws, if they need to remedy any lack of stakeholder diversity. The Board will also select a Secretary at this meeting. Because now you are an official, remember you are subject to the Brown Act. Notice of Meetings must be posted 72 hours or 3 business days before your meeting.
